

Challenge: Loss of inpatient nephrology coverage

Roxborough Memorial Hospital, a 131-bed facility in Northwest Philadelphia, faced a critical gap when its local nephrology group could no longer provide inpatient coverage. Without specialists onsite, patients requiring dialysis and advanced kidney care would have to be transferred to other hospitals—disrupting families, lowering satisfaction, and draining hospital revenue.

Solution: Dedicated TeleNephrology services

Rather than rely on locums or wait months to recruit, Roxborough partnered with AmplifyMD for 100% virtual nephrology coverage, including dialysis management. AmplifyMD provided both the physician and the hardware-agnostic technology, giving the hospital a comprehensive solution for initial consults, follow-ups, daily rounding, and acute patient escalations.

Five keys to 100% remote dialysis management

- **Proactive dialysis order management.** TeleNephrologists place orders directly, reducing bottlenecks and keeping treatments on schedule.
- **Daily coordination with nurses.** Early morning huddles help nurses prioritize patients and avoid scheduling delays.
- Structured handoffs with hospitalists. Sharing treatment details and discharge readiness expedites patient throughput.
- Continuous team communication. Clear channels between TeleNephrologists and onsite providers ensure urgent needs are addressed quickly.
- Integration into hospital workflows. TeleNephrologists join rounds virtually, review labs in real time, and align with care plans to keep the model seamless.
